# Data Playbook

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## Introduction

We are so delighted that you are interested in learning how to use data to help support your innovation efforts. This playbook will be broken down into several sections to allow you to navigate more easily to the parts that are of interest to you. The first section is for data that is available for internal users behind the VA firewall only (sorry partners), and the second section is data that is freely available for any user. In each instance, we aim to describe the kind of question you might be asking that might lead you to that data source to help you navigate to the right information. The Data Playbook is a living document that will continue to be edited as more resources become available or known to us.

## Data Sources within the VA Firewall

### VHA Reports and Measures Portal (RAMP)

Want to remember one place to go for reports and analytic tools that have already been developed?

VHA RAMP is your place. It is a searchable database. If you aren't sure what report might have the information you need, you can type in keywords related to your area of interest to see what reports and measures might be helpful to you. Depending on your position, you may need to request access to specific tools. Click on the image below to see what you can find in VHA RAMP.



## What's in VHA RAMP? Pretty much everything!

- Are you curious about how different VA Medical centers compare in terms of *quality* or how your medical center ranks of various quality metrics?
- Do you want to know more about *productivity* and *business models* for various hospital units?
- Is *patient or employee satisfaction* part of your project?
- Do you want to know more about VA *inpatient* and *surgical* care?
- Is *VHA Community Care* the topic of your curiosity?
- Are you trying to understand VHA *nursing* practice?
- Do you want to know more about specific *patient care outcomes* at the PHI level, and how to better care for your *assigned panel* of patients?
- Is *telehealth* utilization the area you want to take action on?

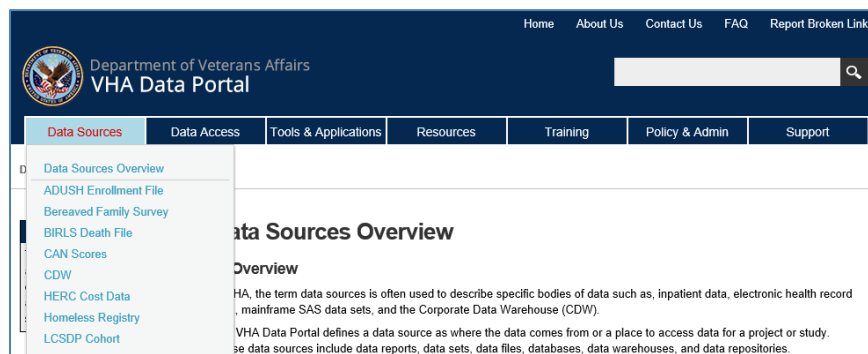
## VHA Data Portal

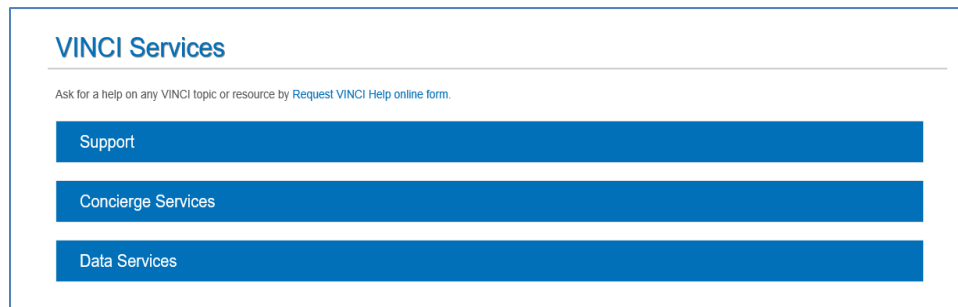
## VHA Data Portal Sources

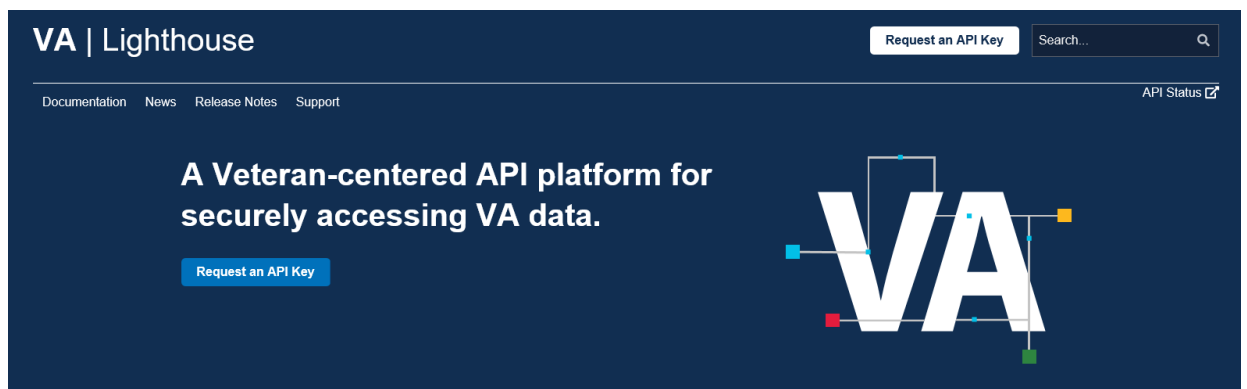


## Open Access Data Sets

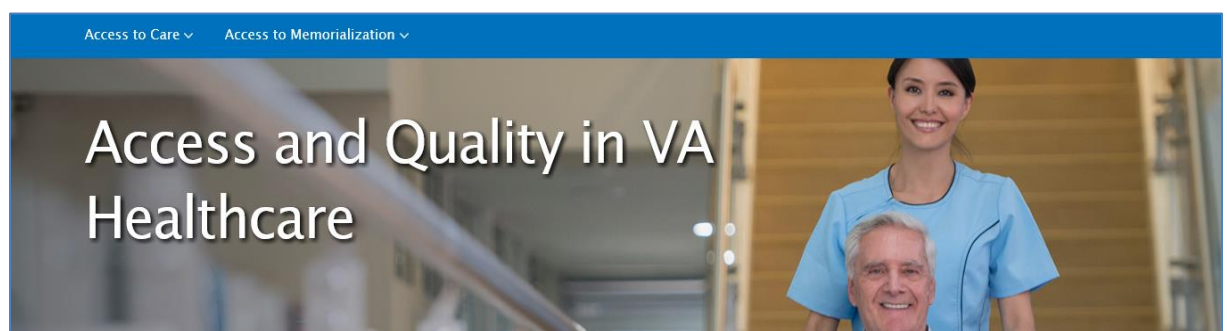
### Application Programming Interface (API)

Want an API for EHR, Benefits, Facilities, Forms, and Veteran Verification (synthetic data) to safely and securely test out ideas and learn? We are always looking for how we can provide even better service and support. If you'd like to work on any of these areas and want to test your idea before getting access to PHI, Lighthouse API is your place.



### Quality and Access Data

Want to learn more about access and quality metrics at various VA facilities, being able to compare VA facilities to other VA and non-VA facilities? On this site you can compare VA to non-VA care and within VA care. You can learn more about access data across the nation and for your local facility. You can also look at Veteran Satisfaction data.



### Population Level Statistics



Want to learn generally about the Veteran population including where Veterans live, population changes, demographic shifts, use of VA services? The National Center for Veterans Analysis and Statistics is a great resource for current data about the Veteran population as well as projections for the future.


**Who We Are and What We Do**

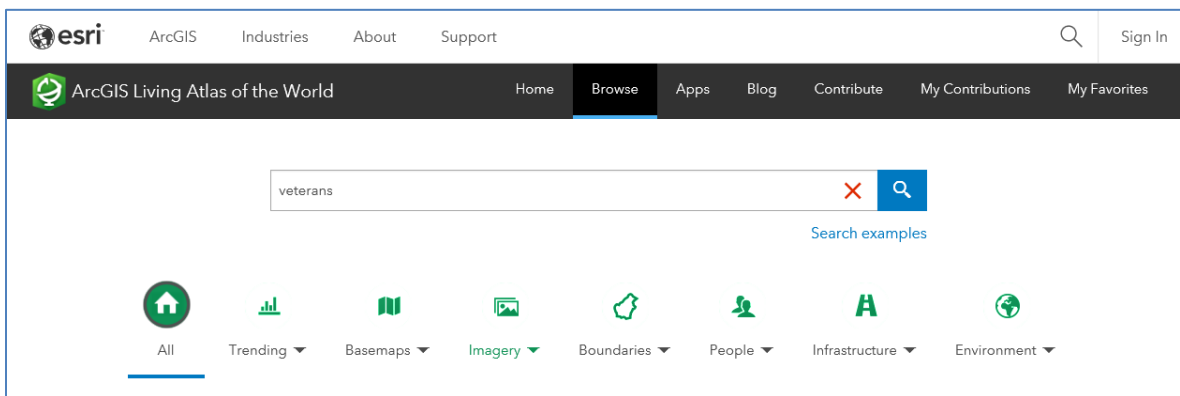
## Maps and Visualizations
